Academy County and Travel Program Tryouts

2023/24 Seasons

The County program tryouts for the 2023 Fall season and the Travel program for the 2023 Fall/Spring 2024 season will be held the weeks of May 15 and May 22. Players should register before May 14! Players must have soccer shin pads and should bring a ball and water. We strongly recommend soccer cleats and remind you that baseball and football cleats with a front cleat ARE NOT allowed for soccer.

Registration will open April 17 and there is no cost to register and attend tryouts. You will receive an email after tryouts are complete informing you of the results. If you have been selected for either the County or the Travel program, you will receive a link to accept the invitation and pay your non-refundable fees. Fees must be paid by July 1 in order to secure placement.

Players selected for the County program must pay the team fee upon acceptance of the invitation to play in the Fall season. The County program fee is \$250 per player, per season for U8–U12 and \$300 per player per season for U13 and above.

Players selected for the Travel program must pay the team fee upon acceptance of the invitation to play for the entire 2023/24 season. Fee for the Travel program is \$500 per player per year for U12 and below and \$600 per player per year for U13 and above. Uniforms for both programs are purchased at an additional cost to the player. Additional fees may apply for items such as tournaments.

- The U4-U8 Developmental Summer Camp will be July 24–28 and will focus on basic soccer skills and teamwork. Children must be born in 2019 or later to be eligible for camp. Cost is \$100 and will run from 6:00 pm–7:30 pm.

Coach's Corner


Question: Do you have that soccer player that is constantly kicking at the walls of the house and breaking your walls or furniture? **Answer:** Try a soccer rebounder/passing wall. A passing wall is a great tool for your soccer player to work on their passes and first touch. Having a good first touch can determine the effects on the ball for the next move.

The first touch determines:

- where the ball goes next
- how fast the ball moves away from the player
- how fast the player can move away with the ball
- where the player can pass the ball
- how easy it will be for an opposing player to tackle the player with the ball
- and many more things

If a player can increase the quality of their first touch, they can reduce the number

of times the opposition gets the ball. And the more possession of the ball a team has, the greater the team's chance of winning the game.
